



VOTING IN NORTH CAROLINA

The 2020 elections will be held on Tuesday, November 3. Here is the complete information for voting before Election Day if you choose.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee ballots will be available in North Carolina beginning September 4. They may be requested until October 27. You can obtain a form to request an absentee ballot at the Moore County Board of Elections website, www.moorecountync.gov/board-of-elections. You may not request an absentee ballot for anyone but yourself.

The US Postal Service anticipates a high number of absentee ballots will be requested and used, so if you choose to vote by absentee ballot you should request the ballot, complete it and mail it in to be sure it will reach the Elections Office by November 3. Any ballot that does not reach the Board of Elections by Election Day will not be counted.

You do not need to show you will be unable to vote on Election Day to obtain an absentee ballot. You also may still vote early or in-person if you choose not to use your absentee ballot.

EARLY VOTING

Early voting will take place from October 15-31. There will be four locations:

Pinehurst Community Center, 210 Rattlesnake Trail, Pinehurst
Vass Town Hall, 140 S. Alma St., Vass

Saturdays 8 am – 3 pm
Sundays 2 pm – 5 pm
